Winter Watch Service

Recommended once a month weather permitting
***Pools prone to scaling recommended biweekly**

Services will be suspended once water is frozen.

By signing up for our Winter Watch program, we can help to minimize the severity of plaster issues such as scaling, etching or pitting. We will visit your pool and perform the following:

- Test & balance your pH, alkalinity and calcium. Agitate the water to properly disperse the chemicals as needed.
- Monitor water levels and pump out water as needed.
- Check the cover pumps and GFCI switches to ensure pump is operational.
- Clean debris off covers and inspect the garden hose.
- Inspect cover security, ie., rubber straps, springs, waterbags, anchors and replace as needed.
- Visual inspection of equipment

DON'T MAKE THIS MISTAKE BEFORE CLOSING

You may be tempted to turn off your equipment, stop servicing your pool or worrying about your water chemistry prior to closing because no one is using the pool. This is a big mistake. Doing so can cause damage to your equipment and cause imperfections in your plaster. To avoid these issues, please maintain your pool until the date of closing.

- Water should be tested and balanced before closing. It is not included in the standard winterization. We will gladly add a chemical kit upon request, however this kit does not include balancing chemicals.
- Pool should be as clean as possible. Please vacuum/clean leaves and debris out prior to closing to avoid possible staining of your pool surface.

2018 SERVICES

WE REQUIRE A 50% DEPOSIT FOR SERVICE. THE BALANCE WILL BE COLLECTED AUTOMATICALLY BY THE SAME FORM OF PAYMENT UPON COMPLETION OF SERVICE.

WINTERIZE POOL \$205.00

Includes blowing water from piping, plugging lines with rubber expansion plugs, draining equipment, and removing ladders, diving boards and rails for indoor storage. Remove, rinse (and reinstall) diatomaceous earth filter elements, bag filters and cartridges. The water level will be lowered to 1" - 2" below the tile. (Mineral cartridges will be removed and discarded for those customers with mineral systems). POOL WILL BE WINTERIZED IN THE CONDITION IN WHICH IT IS FOUND. PLEASE BALANCE PH, ALKALINITY AND HARDNESS PRIOR TO SERVICE SO THE CHEMICALS HAVE A CHANCE TO CIRCULATE.

- \$35.00 extra charge for additional pumps

NOTE: Plastic jet fittings and drain lids degrade over time and can be damaged due to their age when removed. Great Valley Pool Service is not responsible for replacements that may be necessary due to the integrity of these plastic fittings.

WINTERIZE POOL WITH SPA..... \$265.00

Includes all of the above and blowing water from all spa piping and plugging lines with rubber expansion plugs.

- Additional pumps (excluding cleaner pumps) will have an extra charge of \$35.00 per pump to winterize (i.e. water feature, spa jet).
- \$105.00 extra for pools with separate spa systems
- \$60.00 extra for Caretaker filter systems

INSTALL POOL COVER..... \$130.00

If you would like us to set up your cover pump, please place the cover pump, garden hose and extension cords by the pool, and we will be happy to install free of charge. IF THESE ITEMS ARE NOT READILY AVAILABLE BY THE POOL OR YOU WOULD LIKE US TO RETURN TO SET THIS UP AFTER YOUR WINTERIZATION IS ALREADY COMPLETE, A \$75 SERVICE CHARGE WILL APPLY. For water bag covers, any additional water bags needed to properly secure the cover will be added to the final bill. We are not responsible for leaking water bags or for covers that blow in.

*Anchored covers with cable assemblies

- \$30 for assemblies less than 10ft
- \$50 for assemblies over 10ft
- \$75 for cables using waders/floatation devices

WINTERIZATION CHEMICAL KIT..... \$73.99+tax

(For pool up to 30,000 gals.) COMPATIBLE WITH SALT SYSTEMS

- 1/2 Gal Stain & Scale Preventative
- 1 Qt. Algaecide 60
- 1 Non chlorine winter floater

* For pools with past scaling issues or salt systems, we recommend an additional quart of Stain & Scale (\$18.99).

SPA WINTERIZING CHEMICAL KIT..... \$32.99+tax

(Spas or small pools up to 7,500 gals.)

Includes:

- 1 Pint Stain & Scale Preventative
- 1 Pint Algaecide 60
- 1 Small non chlorine winter floater

CLEAN SALT CELL – SALT POOLS..... \$10.00

This is recommended once a year at closing for all salt water pools. Mineral deposits build up on the metal plates of the generator due to the fact that calcium is naturally attracted to the electrically charged plates. When mineral deposits build up too much it blocks the ability for electrolysis to occur. Over time, if this is not cleaned, the build-up can permanently damage the coatings on the plates leading to cell failure.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- We cannot assume responsibility for delays beyond our control.
- We will lower water level 1 - 2" below the tile. If you would like it lowered any additional, it will be billed accordingly at \$30 per quarter hour.
- Motors will remain attached unless otherwise instructed.
- Leaf raking will be billed accordingly \$30/per quarter hour
- Baskets, eyeballs and spa jet fittings age with time and may break during removal. We are not responsible for this damage as their removal is required for proper winterization.
- Certain valve handles, plugs & misc. equipment are placed in the pump pot basket for safe keeping.
- Covers are secured as thoroughly as possible.
- *Please note: it is normal for leaves to blow under the cover during the course of the winter. We are not responsible for leaves.*
- Water should be tested & balanced a few days before closing. It is not included in standard winterization. A winter chemical kit will only be added if requested, but this kit does not balance your pool water. Spa kits are recommended for spas.
- Pool should be as clean as possible. Vacuum/clean leaves out prior to closing, otherwise please schedule in advance if you wish GVPS to clean.
- Pool covers should be available or instruct us as to the whereabouts so it can be obtained.
- Electricity and water will need to be available at poolside. We will need electric at the filter to properly backwash the system.
- Do not shut down systems prior to winterization as freeze damage may occur.
- Additional charges will be applied for diving board hardware that may need to be replaced.
- Shocking or heavily chlorinating prior to winterization may result in premature cover wear. With a pool cover on and our cold water formulated winter algacide, no chlorine is needed.
- Cover pumps, necessary to minimize water displacement and damage to pool structure, must be poolside on closing day. A \$75 service charge will apply for a return trip.

COVER PUMPS: To remove excess water from your safety cover, don't forget to order an AquaGuard Auto Cover Pump, which safeguards against melting snow and rain. These cover pumps can remove 2,100 gallons of water per hour.

COVER PUMP TIPS

- Check your pool cover for holes to avoid draining your pool while pumping off the cover.
- Unplug your pump once the temperature falls below freezing.
- Do not allow your pump to freeze into your cover.
- For mesh covers, use a cover pump under the cover on the top step to keep the water level from getting too high.
- For solid covers, use a cover pump on top of the cover to pump off excess water.

WHY USE A SAFETY COVER?

The number one reason pool owners invest in safety covers is to provide protection and prevent accidental intrusion of children, pets, or other animals. Pool covers help with maintenance to keep pool water free of debris and assist with ideal water conditions.

SAFETY COVER ADVANTAGES

- Secure – prevents access to the pool by children and pets
- Protective – minimizes debris in the pool and the growth of bacteria and algae
- Durable – resists tears, rips, and sun damage
- Long-lasting – lasts up to 12 years on average, longer than tarp pool covers

MESH VS. SOLID SAFETY COVERS

Once you decide to invest in a safety cover, the next step is to determine the type of cover. There are two types: tightly woven mesh safety covers and reinforced vinyl, solid safety covers.

Unlike tarp covers, both types of safety covers provide a close-fitting and secure cover over your pool that are anchored into the surrounding pool deck. Safety covers are unlike tarp covers that use unsightly water bags, which can get



holes and lose their water or fall into the pool, many times taking the cover with it. Tarp covers can also sag, creating a mess of pooled water and leaves that generate a habitat for frogs and other wildlife.

DEFENDER MESH COVER FEATURES

- Blocks 98% of sunlight, minimizing the growth of algae in balanced, chlorinated water
- Allows rain water and snow to pass through
